## CPCG 'Caravan' at Stockwell Gardens Estate

For years now residents of the Stockwell Gardens Estate have had their lives disrupted by antisocial behaviour and violent gang activity, mainly from groups and gangs of youths from outside the area. There is something about the proximity of numerous bus and underground links as well as the number of access and exit points within the estate that attracts these unwanted visitors. Added to which, the limited space for social and sports activities have, for various reasons, become unusable for young people from the estate in the evenings.

Working with the Tenants and Residents Association on Stockwell Gardens and with help from the nearby Grantham Estate, the CPCG facilitated a closed meeting between the residents and the Lambeth Police, Community Safety, Hyde Housing and Lambeth's Youth Service to set up a Steering Committee drawn from the residents at the meeting to implement an Action Plan which will be evaluated later in the year.

Having facilitated the process Lambeth's CPCG will, if the residents wish, monitor its progress and participate in the evaluation.
