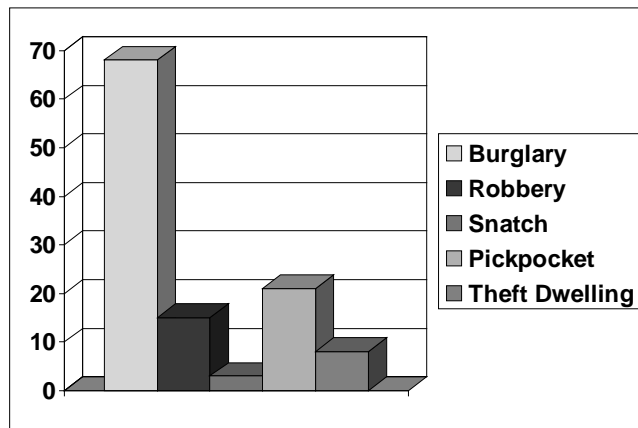

Summary



Since 1st of April 2006 388 reported crimes with victims over 65. The most prevalent offence is Burglary with 68 offences since April 2006.

Distraction Burglary

- Offences where the victim is distracted by the suspects using a cover such as;

Assumed Identities

- Water board official
- Gas man
- Police officer

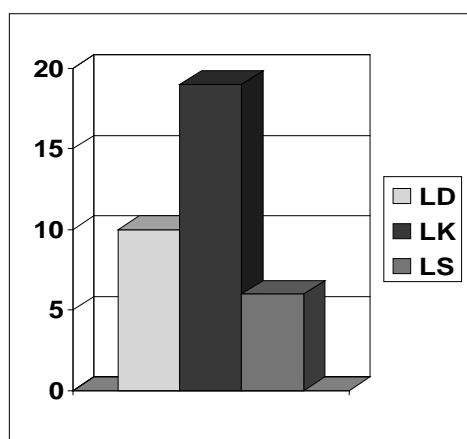
Cover Stories

- Leak downstairs
- Selling cheap cigarettes
- Car broken down and need to use phone

- The victims allow access and while dealing with one of the suspects further suspects enter the premises and steal property.

- The suspects tend to target the elderly.

Artifice Offences 2006



- Since Jan 2006 a total of 35 offences of Distraction Burglary.

- LK - 6
- LS - 19

Victim Profiles

- **The average age of victims of distraction Burglary is 74 years of age.**
- **The eldest victim was 90 years of age.**
- **Of the 35 reported offences only 4 offences have victims under the age of 65.**

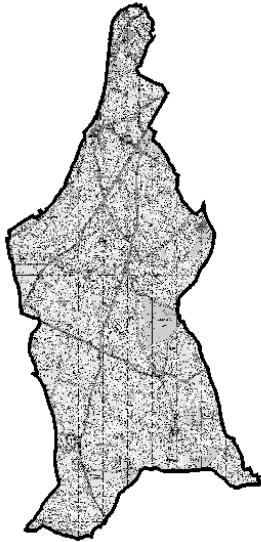


Suspect Profiles

- **The offences involving the use of assumed identities tend to be committed by members of the travelling community.**
 - **The suspects are from locations all over London and the home counties.**
- **The suspects for the other forms of offences are often drug users and are generally from the local area.**
- **Recently there has been a number of suspects described as being Eastern European**



Prevalent areas



The wards most hit by distraction offences are as follows.

- Brixton Hill – 5 offences
- Streatham Wells – 4 offences
- Knights Hill – 4 offences

Temporal Analysis

- **Most Distraction offences occur in the afternoon during the hours of daylight.**
- **The most common M.O is Water Board official or Leak.**

Case Study

- **Between October 2005 and November 2005 WALKER targeted members of the Brixton Community. He pretended to be a plumber explaining that there was a leak and that he need to turn off the water. On gaining entry he would steal what was to hand, normally cash.**
- **He was arrested following a forensic identification and was interviewed and subsequently charged with four burglaries and a further 20 were taken into consideration.**
- **He subsequently pleaded guilty at court and was sentenced to 10 years imprisonment.**
- **Earliest date of release 25/01/2010**

OPERATION BLUNT PRELIMINARY RESULTS

Operation Blunt activities for 2006 started on 15/05/2006. The enforcement phase ran between 15/05/2006 and 21/05/2006. Between 22/05/2006 and 30/06/2006 a knife amnesty was held.

In the 47 day period since the beginning of Operation Blunt activities, there have been **67 offences** across Lambeth Borough in which a knife has been used.

Decrease of 2.30% compared to the period before the operation.

Decrease of 16.25% compared to the same period last year.

There have been **20 offences** relating to the possession of knives across the Borough.

This is an **increase of 3 offences** or 17.65% compared to the previous period.

OPERATION BLUNT PRELIMINARY RESULTS

Knife amnesty

324 knives were handed in as a result of the knife amnesty across Lambeth Borough between 22/05/2006 and 30/06/2006.

Offences of note

During the period of operation there was one fatal offence on Lambeth Borough in which a knife was used. This was the fatal stabbing of Alex Kamondo which attracted national attention, following just 3 weeks after the fatal stabbing of Kiyon PRINCE in Barnet.

In this period there have also been 10 GBH offences in which knives have been used resulting in serious injury. These were spread over the Borough with the highest number in LS. They ranged from domestic incidents to street fights.

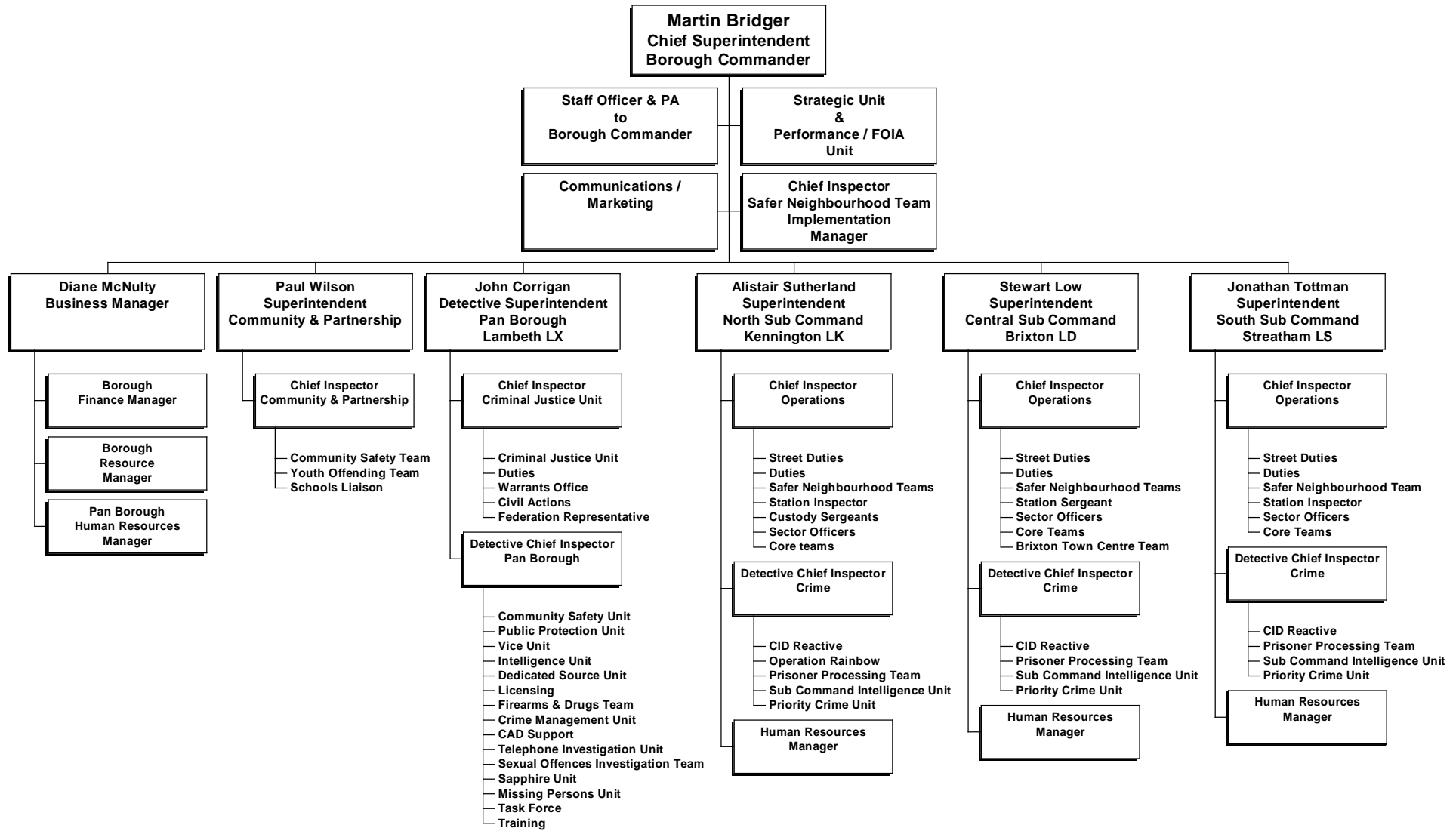

Glossary

‘Sanctioned’ and ‘Non Sanctioned’ Detection Definitions

A ‘Sanctioned’ Detection is where an allegation has resulted in either a charge, a summons, a caution, a formal warning, a youth reprimand or an offence being taken into consideration i.e. in addition to the charge for which the person is before a court, other offences can be admitted by the defendant and the court asked to take these offences into consideration in passing sentence.

A ‘Non-Sanctioned’ Detection is where a crime has been committed and recorded and:

A suspect has been identified and interviewed by a police officer or, if an interview is not necessary to determine guilt, had at least been informed that the offence has been detected.

There must be sufficient evidence to charge the suspect with the crime.

If the victim subsequently refuses to give evidence, then a reason for this decision has been documented.

In the case where there is an identifiable victim, the victim must have been informed that the crime has been detected or in the case of a child, the parent or guardian has been informed.

Total Robbery

Combination of Robbery and Theft-Snatch

Robbery

Theft where force or threat of force is made to a person at the time or immediately before in order to steal

Theft - Snatch

Theft where force is applied to the object carried by a person ie snatching an handbag or phone from a person

Motor Vehicle Crime

Combination of theft from vehicles or taking of vehicles with the owners consent or theft of a motor vehicle

Gun Enabled Crime

A crime which is a specific listed offence ie assaults, thefts or sexual offences whilst in possession of a firearm or imitation firearm and the firearm has been seen or used

ABH

Assault where cuts bruises and other types of minor injuries are sustained

GBH

Serious assault resulting in permanent injury broken bones

TNO Total Notifiable Offences

All notifiable offences which are recorded by police and a crime report is generated

I-Call

Police graded response to a call received in the Police Control Room. Immediate response within 12mins. For incidents where a suspect is still on scene/nearby or immediate danger is perceived

CAD

Computer aided dispatch which is the computer system used within Metropolitan Police Control rooms to record incidents
