## Murder Investigations Update 2006

- **Khizar Hayat & Hamidullah Hamidi** On 27/04/2006 a male threw a petrol bomb into the venue. Trial date set for 14<sup>th</sup> July 2007 at CCC.
- **Simon Monteiro** Victim died on 11/05/2006 single stab wound to chest in Stockwell Road. Enqs Continue to identify a suspect.
- **Mark Murphy** On 22/08/2006 at 24, Bournevale Road, London, SW16 Victim stabbed. 1 Suspect charged. Trial at CCC Suspect Patricia Gillette was not fit to plead but evidence was put before a jury and she is to be held indefinitely.

## Murder Investigations Update 2006

- **Anton Smith** shot 4 times 20/10/2006 rear of 207 Clapham Park Rd 2 Suspects charged with murder
- Current Trial date set for September.
- **Jason Dawes** 11/12/2006 found dead with a number of stab wounds Cold Harbour Lane. Suspect charged remanded in custody awaits trial CCC November 2007.

## Murder Investigations Update 2007

- **Catherine Marlow** 13/01/2007 66 South Lambeth Road, SW8
- Matthew Fagan, remanded in custody to the Central Criminal Court trial set for 25/02/2008
- **Michael Edwards** 21/01/2007 Hart House, St Martins Estate, Kennington stabbed Suspect awaiting trial CCC Jan 2008
- **James Smarrt – Ford** 03/02/2007 Shot at Streatham Ice Rink. Fifteen arrests made 5 still on bail enqs continue.



## Murder Investigations Update 2007

- **William Cox** 14/02/2007 shot at his house in Fenwick Place. 1 arrested to date currently on bail until August. Enquiries Continue.
- **Stephen O'Neill** aged 54 years 03/04/2007 32 Orsett Street, SE11, assaulted causing fatal injuries. 1 suspect arrested enqs continued
- **Alfred Christopher Liverpool**, male IC3 27/04/2007 Flat 6 Clarence House Rushcroft Road SW2 murder by shooting. No suspects at this stage. Enqs continue

- **Mohamed Nateez Abdulraheem AKA Rizmi Raheem**
- Sri Lankan Male aged 31 years 02/06/2007 found trussed up and murdered at 5 Sardeson House, SE27.
- 3 Charged remanded in custody awaits trial CCC.

- 03/06/2007 Yanire Izaja aged 2 died as a result of her injuries caused by her father . Parliament View
- Suspect on bail until September 2007 currently under section 3 Mental Health Act .
  
- 05/06/2007 AYALA-CARMONA Carlos Andres & FUENTE Reuben Rodriguez
- 18 Muller Road 2 victims both stabbed Suspects outstanding.



## **Murder Investigations Update 2007**

- 15/06/2007 Key House Bowling Green Street
- Orlando THOMPSON stabbed twice
- 1 suspect charged on remand 3 currently on bail
  
- 20/06/2007 Abercairn Road
- Ken HONG came out of his house to discover a suspect in his vehicle. Victim was eventually thrown from the vehicle by the suspect driven at speed. No suspects enqs continue

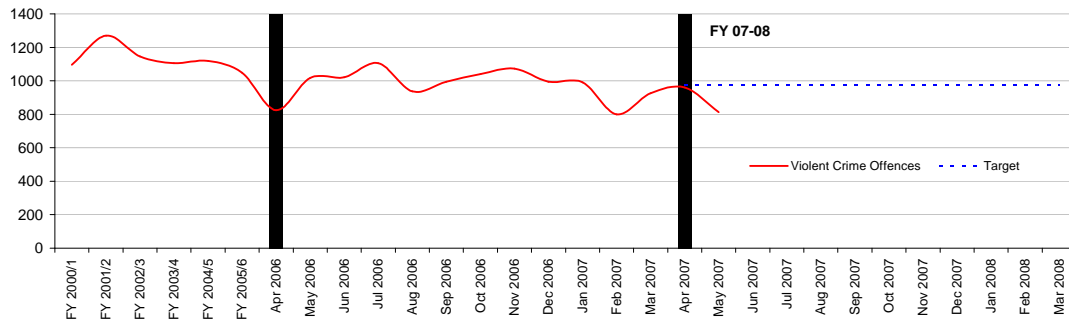

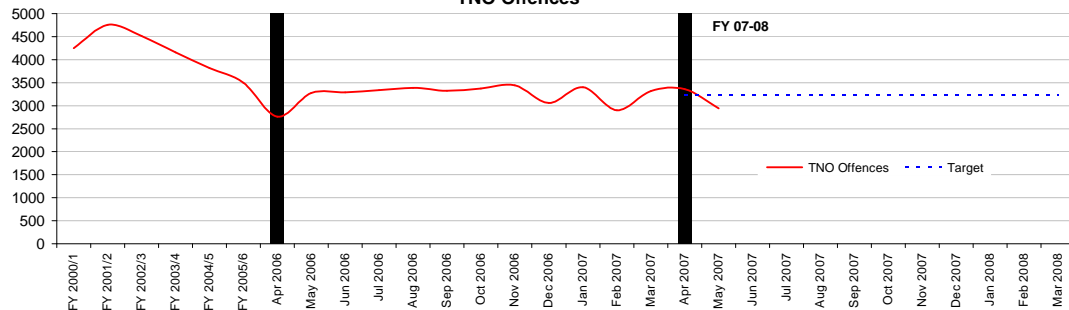

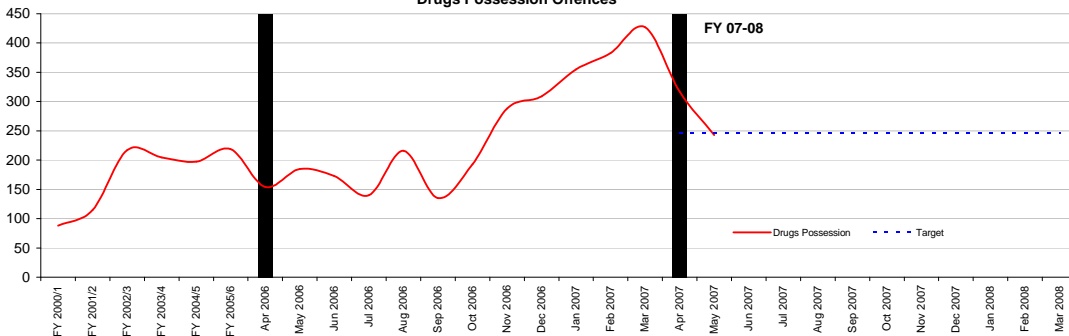

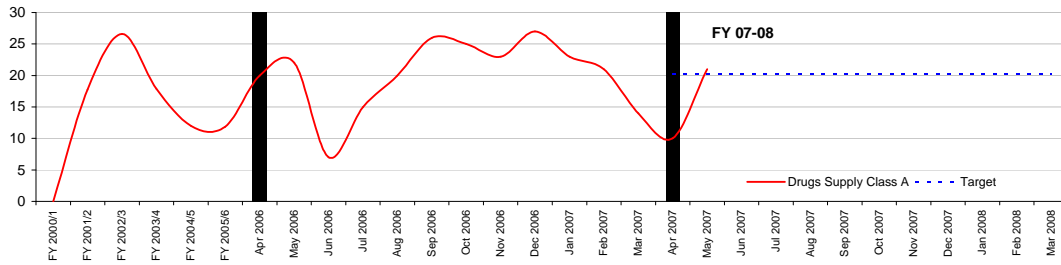

## **Glossary**

### **‘Sanctioned’ and ‘Non Sanctioned’ Detection Definitions**

A ‘Sanctioned’ Detection is where an allegation has resulted in either a charge, a summons, a caution, a formal warning, a youth reprimand or an offence being taken into consideration i.e. in addition to the charge for which the person is before a court, other offences can be admitted by the defendant and the court asked to take these offences into consideration in passing sentence.

A ‘Non-Sanctioned’ Detection is where a crime has been committed and recorded and: A suspect has been identified and interviewed by a police officer or, if an interview is not necessary to determine guilt, had at least been informed that the offence has been detected.

There must be sufficient evidence to charge the suspect with the crime.

If the victim subsequently refuses to give evidence, then a reason for this decision has been documented.

In the case where there is an identifiable victim, the victim must have been informed that the crime has been detected or in the case of a child, the parent or guardian has been informed.

### **Total Robbery**

Combination of Robbery and Theft-Snatch

### **Robbery**

Theft where force or threat of force is made to a person at the time or immediately before in order to steal

### **Theft - Snatch**

Theft where force is applied to the object carried by a person ie snatching an handbag or phone from a person

### **Motor Vehicle Crime**

Combination of theft from vehicles or taking of vehicles with the owners consent or theft of a motor vehicle

### **Gun Enabled Crime**

A crime which is a specific listed offence ie assaults, thefts or sexual offences whilst in possession of a firearm or imitation firearm and the firearm has been seen or used

### **ABH**

Assault where cuts bruises and other types of minor injuries are sustained

### **GBH**

Serious assault resulting in permanent injury broken bones

### **TNO Total Notifiable Offences**

All notifiable offences which are recorded by police and a crime report is generated

### **I-Call**

Police graded response to a call received in the Police Control Room. Immediate response within 12mins. For incidents where a suspect is still on scene/nearby or immediate danger is perceived

### **CAD**

Computer aided dispatch which is the computer system used within Metropolitan Police Control rooms to record incidents
