## Performance 07/08

- Fewer Victims
- More Detections
- Confidence & Trust
- Feeling Safer
- Value for Money
- Professional Team



## Performance 07/08 Fewer Victims

### Six consecutive years of crime reduction

07/08 figures:

- PSA 1                      *2362 fewer victims*
- TNOs                        *3013 fewer victims*
- Gun Crime                 *17 fewer victims*
- Robbery                    *468 fewer victims*
- Burglary                    *63 more victims*
- Motor vehicle crime      *368 fewer victims*
- BCS Assaults             *644 fewer victims*



## Performance 07/08 More Detections

- TNO SDs 25.9% (*target 24%*)
- Gun Crime SDs 24.8% (*no BCU target*)
- Robbery SDs 10.9% (*target 14%*)
- Burglary SDs 8.2% (*target 20%*)



## Performance 07/08 More Detections (cont'd) - Hate Crime

- Domestic Violence SDs 42.4% (*target 40%*)
- Racist SDs 49.1% (*target 36%*)
- Homophobic SDs 36.4% (*target 33%*)
- Rape SDs 33.3% (*target 30%*)
- DV Offences Arrest rate 55.3% (*target 50%*)



## Performance 07/08 Confidence & Trust

How good a job do police do in Lambeth?

- 07/08 59% (MPS 56%)
- 06/07 56% (MPS 56%)

Fear Of Crime – Violence (*number highly worried*)

- 07/08 11% (MPS 13%)
- 06/07 11% (MPS 11%)



## Performance 07/08 Confidence & Trust (cont'd)

Crime Victim Satisfaction with initial police action

- 07/08 73.1% (MPS 73.3%) Target 78%

Crime Victim Satisfaction with police follow up

- 07/08 58.4% (MPS 59.6%) Target 63%



## **Performance 07/08**

### **Feeling Safer**

Feel safe walking alone during the day

- 07/08 94% (MPS 97%)
- 06/07 96% (MPS 96%)

Feel safe walking alone after dark

- 07/08 67% (MPS 73%)
- 06/07 74% (MPS 74%)



## **Performance 07/08**

### **Value for Money**

- Lambeth within budget 07/08
- Partnership intelligence office
- Police officers within St Thomas' hospital
- Income generation officer
- Wide range of local Value for Money measurements/targets



## **Performance 07/08 Professional Team**

- Capability review within Serious Violence Reduction Strategy
- Police officer sickness - lowest level in our 'most similar group' (MSG) of 14 other boroughs
- Police staff sickness - 5th lowest in our MSG
- Conflict management training for all staff

## What are the reasons for changing?

Crime Type	FY 2001 – 2002 Offences	FY 2007 – 2008 Offences	Comparative changes
Violence Against the person	8,232	7,664	Reduction of 568 victims -7% Decrease
Robbery	6,465	2,428	Reduction of 4,037 victims -62% Decrease
Murder	17	23	Increase in 6 victims + 35% Increase
Burglary	6,974	3,691	Reduction of 3,283 victims -47% Decrease
Theft and Handling	22,206	12,428	Reduction of 9,778 victims -44% Decrease
Drugs	1,733	3,767	Increase of 2,034 offences + 117% Increase
<b>Total Notifiable Offences</b>	<b>57,092</b>	<b>35,855</b>	Reduction of 21,237 victims -37% Decrease
