# Fatal Collision

- At approximately 8.40pm on 30 August 2008 a marked police car attempted to stop a moped in Greenhurst Road, West Norwood SE27.
  - The moped drove on and was followed by the car.
  - In Lancaster Avenue SE27 the rider came off the moped at approximately 8.45pm
  - Officers gave first aid and the London Ambulance Service was called.
  - The rider was taken to a south London hospital where his life was pronounced extinct shortly after arrival. He was a 15-year-old youth and his next of kin have been informed and are being kept updated by police
  - The Directorate of Professional Standards has been informed and have initiated an inquiry into the circumstances of the incident in consultation with the IPCC

- Young and Safe - £2 Million set aside for partnership work
- Serious Violence PAG -serious violence strategic partnership meeting
- Summer Schools -21 years of project 750 youths aged 9 –16 attended five sites
- San Francisco Visit –taken USA learning and implemented
- SNT Primary School Involvement Programme -4 Wards developed educational programme for 8-11 age group
- Gang Help line - local number parents/youths can contact for local advice contact
- Community Risk Reduction Panels-panel to identify potential risk issues

# Lambeth Serious Violence - Prevention

- **Outreach-** support young person exit gangs & gang culture.
- **Parent Support Group -** to assist parents divert children away from gang culture / serious violence.
- **Job finder pilot -** 10 referrals 4 –employment & 4 - training.
- **TSG Youth Engagement-** Two projects developed with youth, non-contact boxing programme. workshop to inform young people about 'stop and search'.
- **Diversionsary Project - Vauxhall City Farm-** targeted diversion, educational package for 8-11 age group around knife & gang crime
- **Diversionsary Project - The Globe-** Developing diversionary programme knife awareness to develop links for finding employment.
- **Pathways-** now identified site for Pathways
