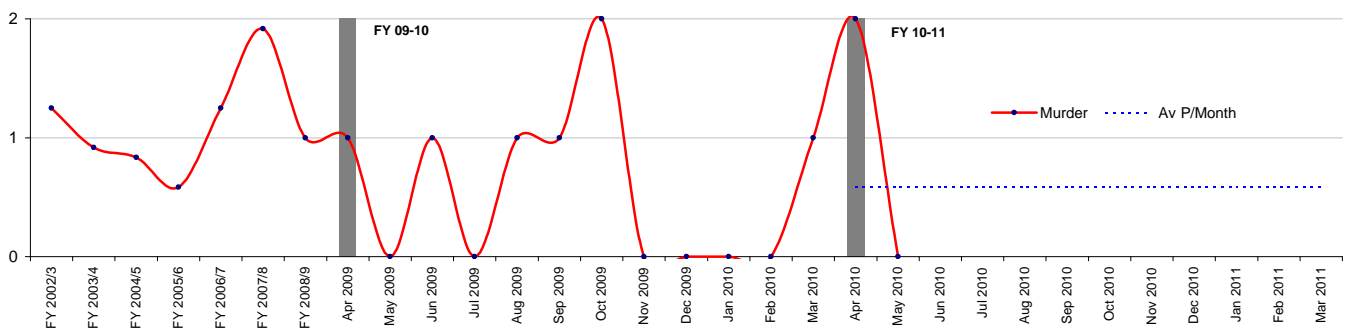

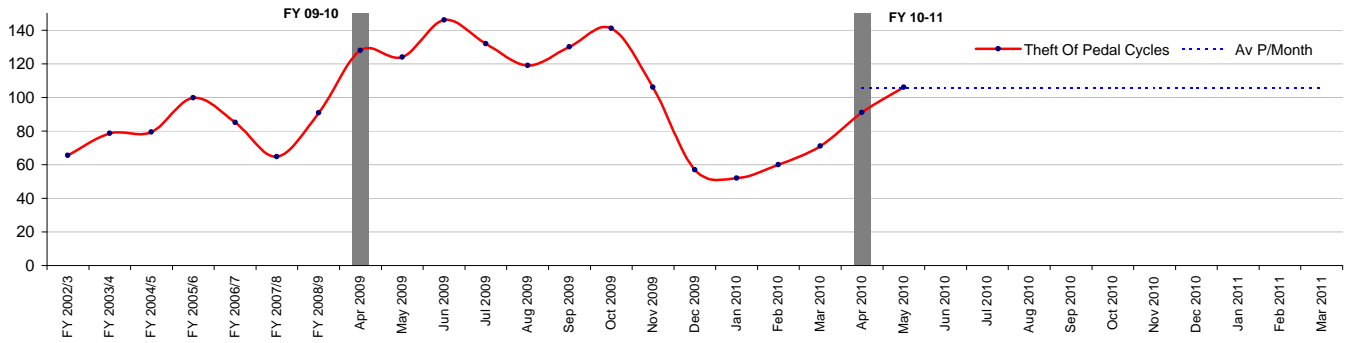

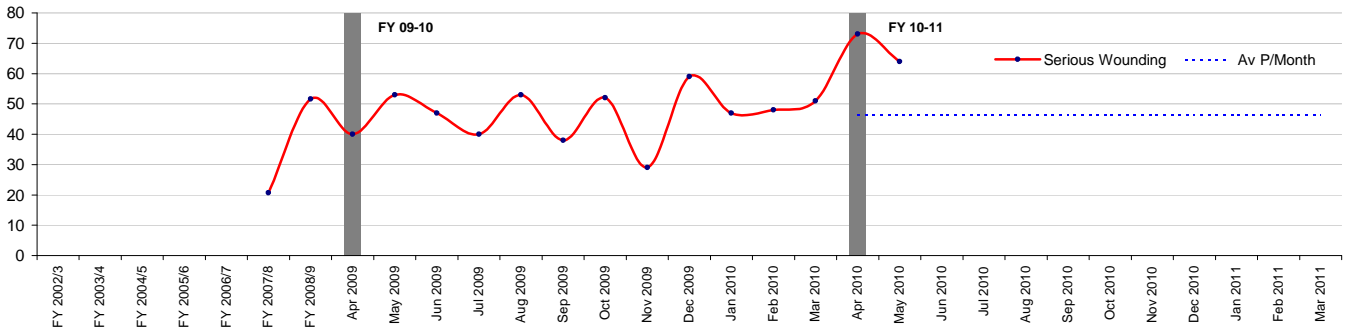

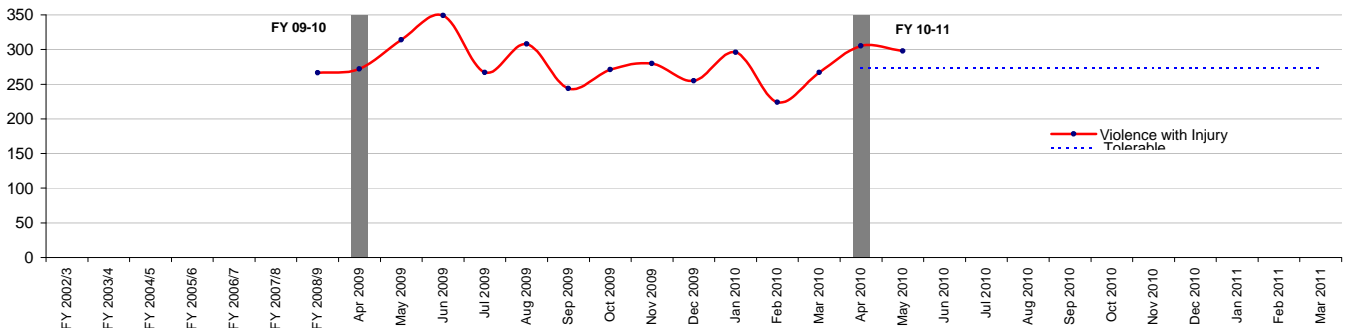

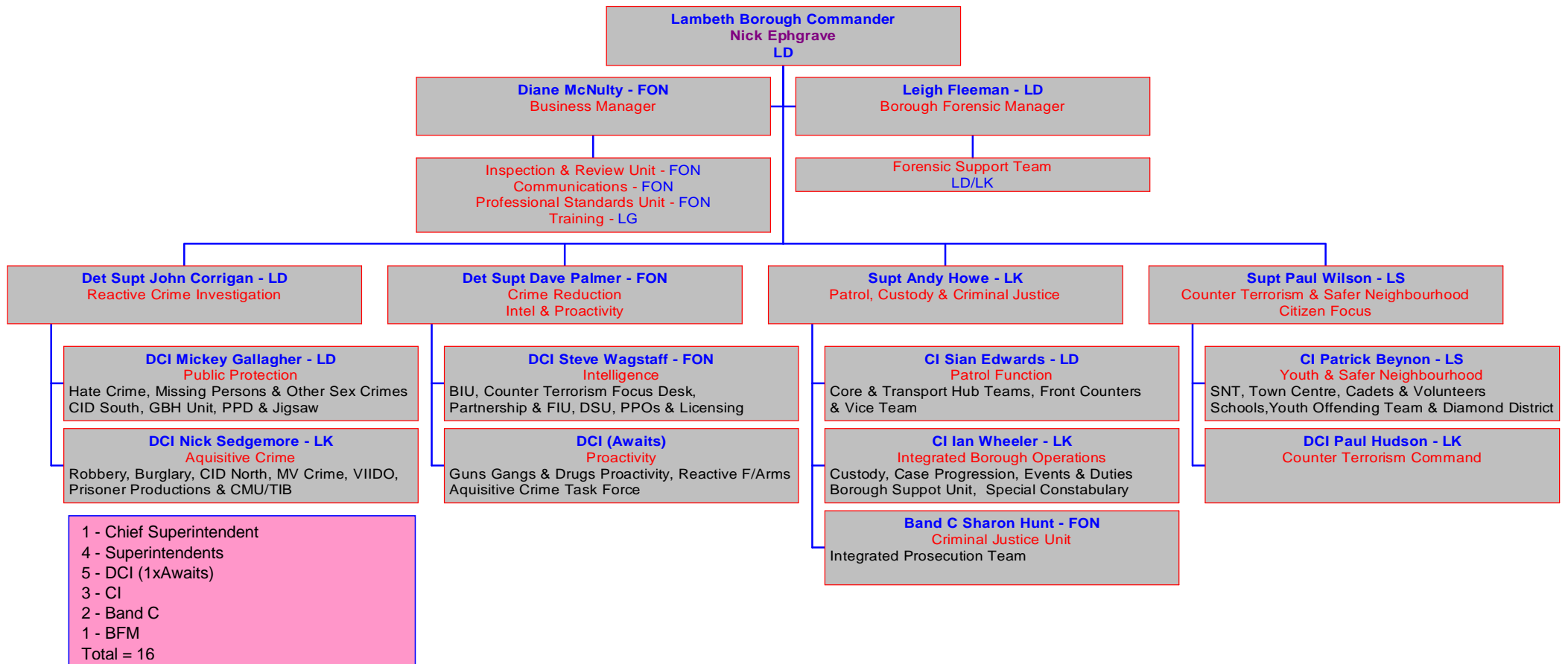

## **Glossary**

### **'Sanctioned' Detection Definition**

A 'Sanctioned' Detection is where an allegation has resulted in either a charge, a summons, a caution, a formal warning, a youth reprimand or an offence being taken into consideration i.e. in addition to the charge for which the person is before a court, other offences can be admitted by the defendant and the court asked to take these offences into consideration in passing sentence.

### **Total Robbery**

Combination of Robbery and Commercial Robbery

### **Robbery**

Theft where force or threat of force is made to a person at the time or immediately before in order to steal

### **TNO Total Notifiable Offences**

All notifiable offences which are recorded by police and a crime report is generated

### **I-Call**

Police graded response to answer a 999 call received in the Police Control Room with 10 seconds. Response Time as per Policing Pledge for urban areas is 12 minutes (within 20 mins for rural areas). Giving an estimated time of arrival (TOA) and getting there safely and quickly as possible.

### **CAD**

Computer aided dispatch which is the computer system used within Metropolitan Police Control rooms to record incidents
